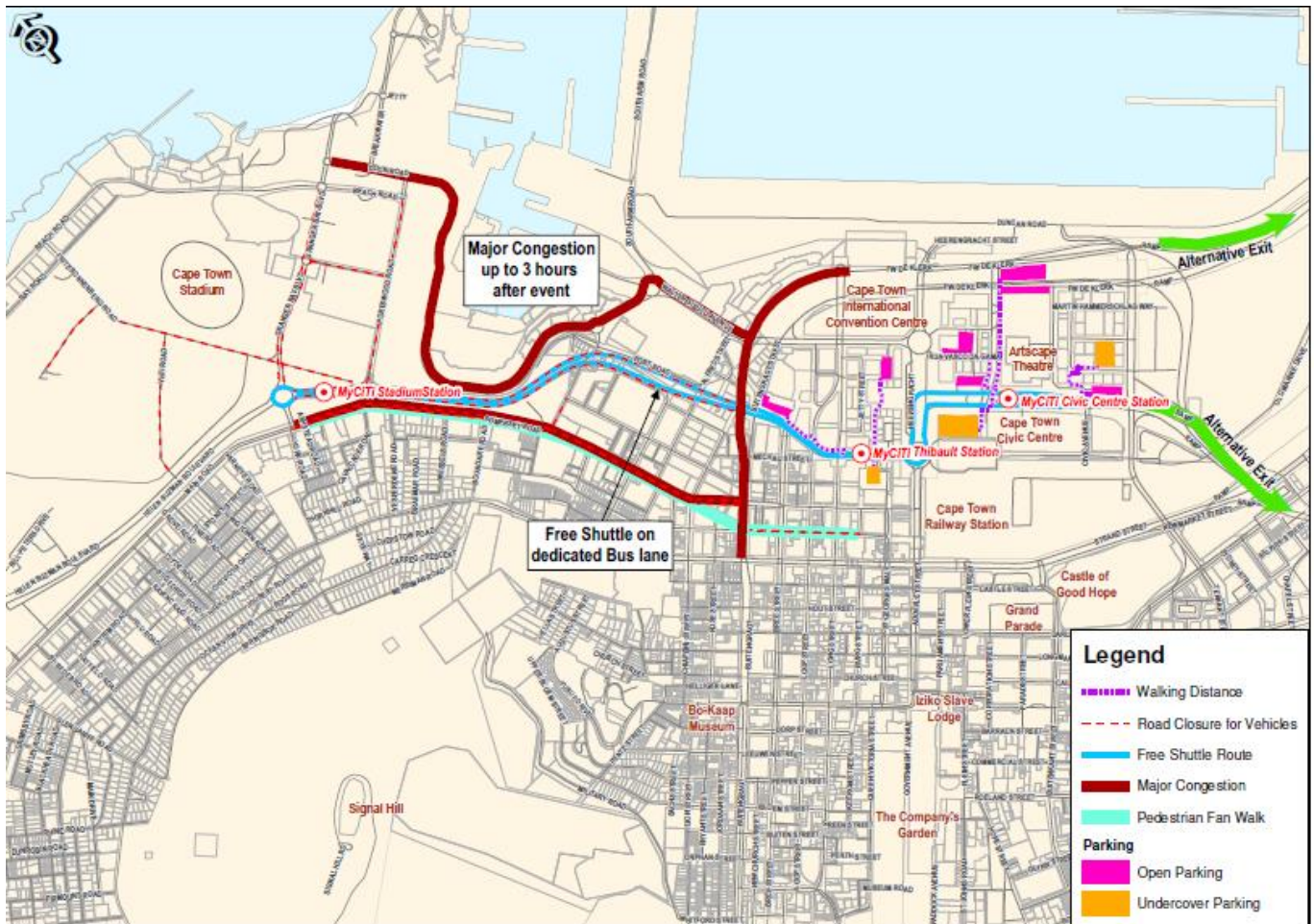
## PUBLIC TRANSPORT

Event ticket holders are encouraged to:-

- Use public transport to the Civic Centre bus station and either catch the free event shuttle to the Stadium or use the Fan Walk. Please see the MyCiti and Events Shuttle sections below for more information.
- Use the free on-street parking in the CBD (free after 17:00 on Weekdays) please note that no security will be arranged.
- Use off-street parking at the CTICC, Ryk Tulbagh Square, Picbel Parkade, Plein Park, etc. Use the MyCiti Free Event Shuttle or Fan Walk.
- Use "Pre-Booked Parking at CTICC" this parking can be booked on [www.parkinthe-city.co.za](http://www.parkinthe-city.co.za).
- Park at the V&A Waterfront (pay to use) and walk to the Stadium.

Normal train services will be available before the event. Normal fares will apply.

Limited special MyCiti shuttle services between the stadium and Civic Centre Bus Station will be available.



## Metrorail Services

Metrorail services to Cape Town will run as normal and passengers will be required to be in possession of a valid train ticket.

No special train services will be available **after** the event.

## MyCiTi Services

The standard hours of operation and fares will apply for all the inner city and trunk and feeder routes. Last bus leave from the Stadium 23:30, patrons are advised to move quickly from the Stadium to Civic-use the shuttle.

**Myconnect** cards can be purchased at selected MyCiTi stations or participating retailers. The 24/7 **Transport Information Centre** can be contacted on **0800 65 64 63** for more information.

CHARGES: Normal fees are applicable for transport outlined above.

## COACHES AND BUSES

Private Coaches and Mini bus Taxis may, on a first-come basis, use the limited designated coach parking on Helen Suzman Boulevard westbound between Vlei Roads and Beach road.

## PARK-AND-RIDES

Use CBD parking as listed in "PARKING" section later in this document and use Civic-Stadium shuttle (free to event ticket holders) or the Fan Walk.

Event Private Coaches drop-off & collection (including parking) will be along the eastbound embayment on Helen Suzman.

VIP Hospitality Shuttle service will run from Cape Town International Convention Centre CTICC to P4 at the Stadium, guests will be dropped off along the embayment on Helen Suzman adjacent to P4, collection will be in the same spot as drop off.

VIP Hospitality pre-booked drop off in P4 off Vlei road approved and issued via the Event Organiser.

## Parking

- No parking on Main Road (Somerset Road) west bond from Thursday 06 February 22:00.
- No parking will be permitted on the above roads at the indicated times.
- Access to and egress from parking garages will be allowed to permit holders ONLY.

## IMPACT OF ROAD CLOSURES ON PUBLIC TRANSPORT

### ➤ MyCiti Waterfront service

- The normal scheduled service will **not** be free of charge.
- The service will stop at the Stadium bus station on route to the Waterfront and then will be rerouted from Helen Suzman Boulevard into Portswood Road, turning left into Beach Road and right at the traffic circle into Granger Bay Boulevard.
- Granger Bay bus station will be closed for this period while all other stops and services on the Gardens-Civic-Waterfront route will remain operational.
- Passengers may use the Waterfront (in Breakwater Lane), Stadium bus station and/or Buitengracht stops as alternatives to the Granger Bay bus station.
- On the return journey from the Waterfront, the bus will turn left into Beach Road, right into Portswood Road and left at Helen Suzman Boulevard to continue its normal route to the CBD.

## PARKING

Parking restrictions will be enforced in the residential areas adjacent to Cape Town Stadium from 17:30 to 23:30, including on Main Road.

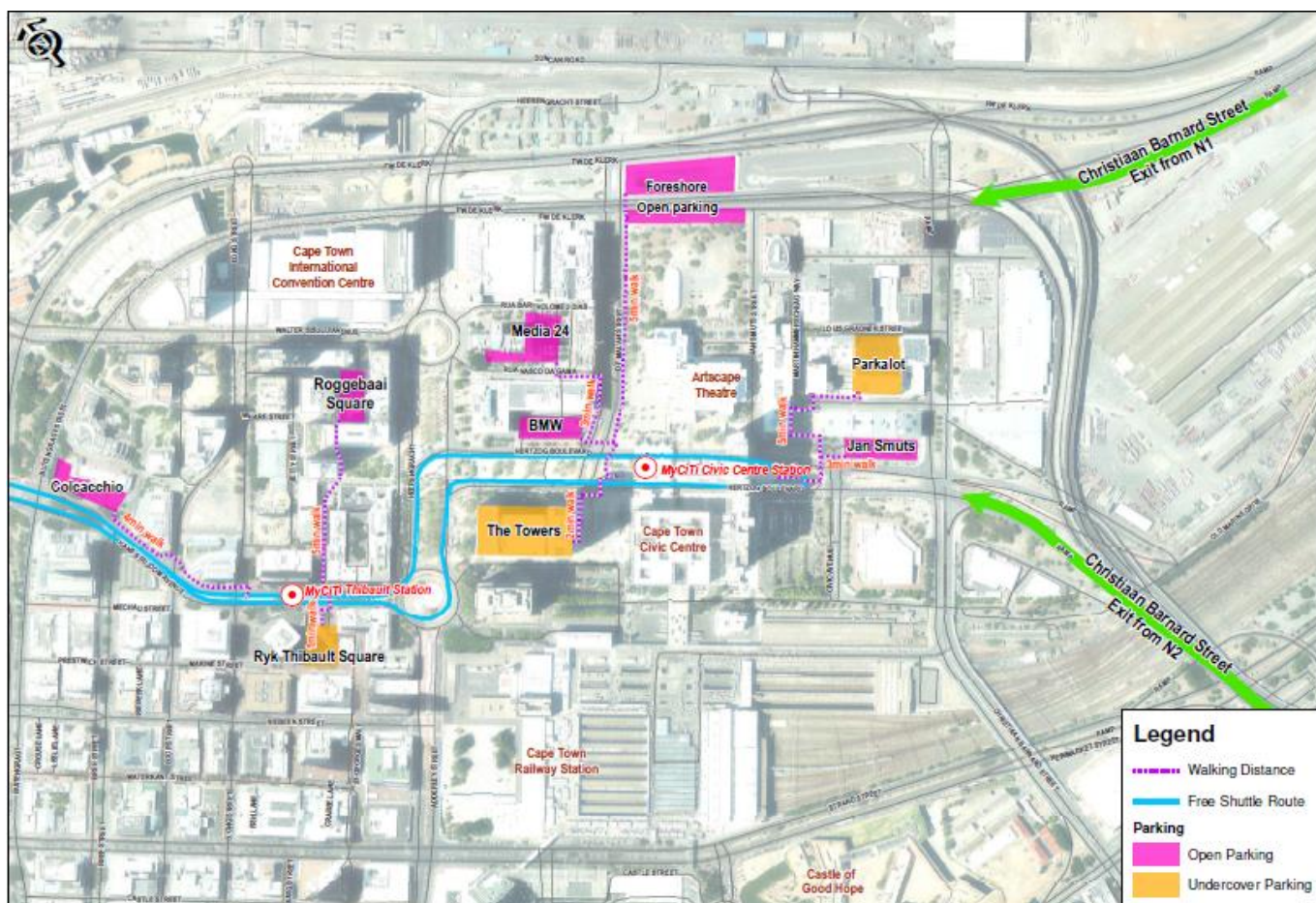
Motorists are advised to obey the signage. Normal restrictions and charges apply to kerbside parking in the CBD for a Weekday.

## REMOTE SEARCH PARK

Remote Search Park will be instituted by SAPS at Gallows Hill for those with P1/P2/P5 and P6 parking VAP's. They are required to enter Gallows Hill Traffic Department off Dock Road towards the Waterfront using either Alfred Road to Ebenezer or take the Ebenezer circle first left turn off Dock road to Gallows Hill Traffic Department.

Remote Search Park available for P5 and P6 from 12:00 (expect delays)





## On-Street in the City Centre

- On-street parking is available within the city centre but no additional security will be provided.
- Parking tariffs will apply until 17:00. Then on-street parking becomes free of charge.

## Off-Street in the City Centre “24/7” off-street parking in the City Centre is available at:

- CTICC,
- Ryk Tulbagh Square,
- Picbel Parkade,
- Plein Park, etc.

## V & A Waterfront

V & A Waterfront has approximately 4000 parking bays available to the general public and a parking charge is associated with this parking. Traffic flows into and out of the V & A Waterfront may be congested.

## Open Parking

Main Road between Grove and Glengriff Streets. However, this is very limited.

## PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES AND SPECIAL NEEDS.

- Dedicated parking has been allocated on DF Malan Drive for people with disabilities who wish to use the Stadium shuttle. Only people with disabilities with an official disability permit from the City will be allowed to park in this dedicated parking area.
- Ticket holders must formally request access to the parking bays dedicated to people with disabilities by sending an e-mail to [ticketing@match-in-africa.com](mailto:ticketing@match-in-africa.com)
- Ticket holders that have purchased disabled seating tickets can email [ticketing@match-in-africa.com](mailto:ticketing@match-in-africa.com) and request disabled parking Vehicle Access Pass for P5 at the stadium. Please note that using this Pass will require you to go through the remote search park set-up at Gallows Hill Traffic Department and there are delays using this service.
- As an alternative the EO has provided an alternative Special Needs Shuttle Service for those with disability or immobility concerns. Special dedicated parking has been arranged at P5 at the CTICC dedicated and pre-booked for special needs patrons. There will be a dedicated shuttle from CTICC to stadium and return for these guests. This is a paid for service. The booking can be made on [www.parkinthe-city.co.za](http://www.parkinthe-city.co.za).

## E- HAILING, DROP-AND-GO & PICK UP

Attendees may be dropped off and collected at the following appropriately signed locations;

- in DF Malan Drive opposite the Artscape Theatre or, Hertzog Boulevard please see parking map.
- The patron is also able to use the drop off area adjacent the Civic Centre Bus Station for those with special needs and then use the service which is disabled friendly and has priority seating for those that require mobility assistance.
- Embayments along Helen Suzman eastbound and westbound is strictly for pre-approved and accredited bus operators to the event, there is no E-hailing drop off area located on Helen Suzman.
- In Jan Smuts Street off Hertzog Blvd in the embayments.

## PEDESTRIAN ROUTES

Pedestrian routes between the Stadium and

- **City Centre (via Fan Walk)- Waterkant Street, over the pedestrian bridge at Buitengracht and Somerset Road to the underpass at Green Point Circle**
  - Part of the road will be open to normal vehicular traffic.
  - Pedestrians are urged to use the sidewalk and dedicated lane to the underpass at Green Point Circle.
- **V & A Waterfront- Grand stairway, over Beach Rd pedestrian crossing and onto Granger Bay Boulevard sidewalk on the stadium side.**
  - This route is via Granger Bay Boulevard.

- Pedestrians are urged to avoid Portwood Road as the pedestrian walkways along that route are restricted.

## CYCLING

Attendees wishing to cycle to the stadium are encouraged to do so. Bicycle racks are located on the eastern (Waterfront) side of the elevated circle at the stadium. Cyclists must provide their own lock and chain as bicycles are left at own risk.

Please remember the "ridesafe" motto and wear a helmet, have adequate lighting and wear reflective clothing (**NB: motorcycle helmets are not allowed inside the stadium**).

Due to the number of people using the Fan Walk, it is advised that cyclists coming from the CBD use the route through the V&A Waterfront or the back roads in De Waterkant to access the stadium.

## TICKET COLLECTION

Attendees must collect their tickets from outlets **before** the day of the event.

NOTE: No pass-outs will be permitted at the stadium on the day.
